Applicants must be able to answer yes to all questions to be considered qualified. Any Applicant who answers no to any of the questions will automatically be disqualified. Additionally, any information requested below must be attached to this application. Verification of the accuracy of responses may occur at any time. Applications must also submit a Summary of Services. Using no more than two pages, the Applicant will provide a statement of their qualifications and describe their program framework. Specifically, the Applicant will describe the services they will provide to Court Users, and their qualifications to provide the services. Application status will be provided to applicants by the chosen vendor from page 2.

1.	The Applicant is in good financial standing and has not filed bankruptcy in the past five (5) years.		
2.	The Applicant is NOT tax delinquent with the State of California or Federal Government and will continue to remain in good standing.		
3.	The Applicant has at least five (5) years-experience providing professional legal services. Such experience may include attorney services or legal support services.		
4.	The Applicant will accept credit cards on-line for payment of Court filing fees and e-Filing services.		
5.	The Applicant will accept fee waivers.		
6.	The Applicant is NOT currently under suspension or debarment with the State of California, and will continue to remain in good standing. http://www.dir.ca.gov/dlse/debar.html
